- Mums share a room with one other mum or it is one child and one mum per room;
- Mums have access to Social Work therapeutic services;
- Once a week mums can attend a spiritual meeting;
- We also provide a volunteer programme, in the ward for children 4 x per week.

Mums can be rest assured that they do not have to worry about their daily needs.
